The Salvation Army Bailey House is a 32 bed Men's Transitional Housing Unit.

We exist to assist men to establish stability in their residency and create a positive tenancy history by short term housing and support services focusing on life skills for housing readiness.

Each individual creates a personal development plan with the guidance of their caseworker outlining their goals for residency.
