The Salvation Army Resource Centre is a drop-in centre for anyone in Yellowknife needing assistance. We offer many in house programs and emergency services, and we also provide outreach and referrals.

## Men's Emergency Shelter

The Men's Emergency shelter operates on a nightly basis and is available to adult men facing homelessness. The shelter is equipped with four bedrooms, totaling 31 sleeping spaces. Two rooms are equipped with new bunk beds, and in addition, 5 beds are reserved for clients in the Productive Choice program.

A soup line at noon and a hot supper meal is provided to men, women and children accompanied by an adult.

Once a week volunteers run a foot washing program where they wash the feet of the men and offer them fresh socks.
